



LEEZEN Alert Bulletin 27th September 2011

Italy

[Rome](#) starts an LEZ for goods vehicles on 1st November 2011, to add to its coach and motorcycle LEZs.

[Lombardy](#) LEZs become permanent from 15th October 2011

[Bolzano / Südtirol's](#) LEZs re-start 1st November 2011 and are in operation all year round, as well as action plan measures after high pollution.

[Emilia-Romagna](#) region LEZs starts 1st October 2011

[Milan's Ecopass](#) is extended until at least 31st December 2011

[Umbria's](#) LEZs in emergency situations ([Perugia](#) & [Ponte San Giovanni](#)) are possible from 10th December 2011

[Aosta](#) LEZ is likely to re-start on 7th November, as the ordinance is not changed from last year. This will be confirmed at the end of October and informed on our website.

[Veneto Province](#) ([Rovigo](#) and [Verona](#)) are expecting to have LEZs this winter, but have not yet confirmed

[Trentino Province](#) has not yet confirmed operation for this winter, but is probably likely

Germany - reminder

[Magdeburg](#) & [Halle \(Saale\)](#) (DE) started LEZ 1st September 2011 

UK - reminder

[London](#) from 1.1.2012 will affect vans Euro 3(PM) and the standard for lorries and coaches will tighten to Euro 4(PM)
